UPS Box Sizes	
<p>8 x 8 x 8 = 9 x 9 x 10</p> <p>12 x 12 x 12 = 13 x 13 x 13</p> <p>16 x 16 x 16 = 17 x 17 x 17</p> <p>20 x 20 x 24 = 21 x 21 x 25</p> <p>24 x 24 x 24 = 25 x 25 x 25</p> <p>*24 x 24 x 24 = 24 x 24 x 30 (>24x24x30 is oversized)</p> <p>12 x 12 x 60 – Small Pipe Box</p> <p>16 x 16 x 60 - Large Pipe Box</p>	<p>*Any box over the standard height for UPS will have to ship Air Freight or LTL.</p> <p>*UPS rate increases if the weight is 75 lbs and above.</p>
UPS Shipping Methods	
<p>UPS Next Day Early – By 8:30 AM if UPS goes to this area.</p> <p>UPS Next Day Air – By 10:30 AM. By 12:00 PM in remote areas.</p> <p>UPS Next Day Air Saver – By 5:00 PM for Next Day service.</p> <p>UPS 2nd Day Air – By 5:00 P.M. for 2-day service.</p> <p>UPS 3 Day Select – By 5:00 PM for 3-day service.</p> <p>UPS Ground – Will deliver by 5:00 PM for Standard Ground transit times</p>

<p>12 x 12 x 60 = (5) 4" QF Pipe</p> <p>12 x 12 x 60 = (4) 5" QF Pipe</p> <p>12 x 12 x 60 = (2) 6" QF Pipe</p> <p>7" - 8" - 9" - 10" - 11" = (1) QF Pipe Per Box In A 12 x 12 x 60 Box</p>	<p>16 x 16 x 60 = (10) 4" QF Pipe</p> <p>16 x 16 x 60 = (6) 5" QF Pipe</p> <p>16 x 16 x 60 = (5) 6" QF Pipe</p> <p>16 x 16 x 60 = (4) 7" QF Pipe</p> <p>16 x 16 x 60 = (2) 8" QF Pipe</p> <p>9" - 10" - 11" - 12" - 13" - 14" - 15" = 1 QF Pipe Per Box</p>
LTL Box Sizes	
<p>40" W x 48" L x 65" L with skid</p> <p>All LTL shipments should not exceed a total Of 6 pallets per shipment. Any amount over this breaks the Volume Capacity Rule. (Defined as taking up over 12 Feet in an LTL carrier.) The LTL carrier will charge a flat rate per mile fee with NO discount.</p> <p>For All Air Freight Deliveries: They have a morning delivery time of before 12:00 PM, some remote areas by 1:30 P.M.</p>
